### **Holiday lesson schedules**

We will be teaching every day except Mondays, except for the following –

December 24<sup>th</sup>: lessons only in the morning.

December 25<sup>th</sup>: no lessons

December 31<sup>st</sup>: lessons only in the morning

January 1<sup>st</sup>: no lessons

### **Cancellation Policy & Lesson Confirmations**

Please note that we require 24-hour notice to cancel your lesson. If you do not cancel within that period or are a no-show for your lesson, you will be charged for the lesson. Lesson confirmation will be sent to you via text message, so make sure you check your phone for those.

### **When you arrive for your lesson**

You should arrive at least 5 minutes before your lesson start time. If you arrive and don't see us up near the horses' stalls, we are down at the arena with the horse you are using for your lesson. Do a quick visual check of the stall and tack room area and then head on down! We will be excited to see you and get started.



### **Reminder: riding attire**

Please remember that you need to have a boot with a heel in order to ride. No sneakers! Additionally, long pants and a shirt with sleeves will help you feel secure in the saddle and stay protected from dust, insects, and the sun. As you progress, you will want to add gloves, breeches, half-chaps, and maybe tall boots as well. Your instructors would be happy to give you recommendations on what you might need.
