



Bell Canyon Riding Academy's COVID-19 Practices and Policies

- ✓ All lessons are currently private-only
- ✓ Students and instructors must stay home if not feeling well or having had recent known exposure to a positive COVID-19 case
 - ✓ Instructors, students, and visitors must be wearing masks while in any barn area
 - ✓ Instructors, students, and visitors must wash hands upon arrival and before leaving
 - ✓ Students and visitors are not to enter barn aisles
- ✓ Students and visitors must maintain a 6' distance from BCRA staff
- ✓ Students may unmask while riding but must re-mask before dismounting
 - ✓ BCRA staff will perform all tacking and untacking properly gloved
- ✓ Tack and grooming supplies will be sanitized regularly

We will do our best to practice methods to protect everyone's safety, but there is still some risk associated with coming to ride. Tack, especially saddles, and horses cannot be perfectly disinfected between riders, and for lower level riders or the event of an emergency social distancing may be difficult to abide to 100% of the time. Keep in mind, scheduling a lesson during this time means accepting these risks.
